Why?

- There are many people with lots of different needs



- People should be able to choose where they want to live
- We need more options



Why not supported living?

- Difficult when someone moves out
- Sometimes people don't get on



- For some people it doesn't meet their needs
- Some people need more care

Young Adults

- May not want supported living



Older Adults

- Sometimes need more or different help because their needs increase

The Proposal

- More options



Residential Care model - Springhill

- Strong connections with the community
- Good support for people who may have dementia
- Residential space for people with learning disabilities
- Respite and support for people with dementia
- Carers space
- Dementia advisors for information and advice



Extra Care Housing

- Your own tenancy
- Living independently in your home
- Special facilities - assistive technology
- Care and support 24 hours a day
- Different ages and needs
- Could have a restaurant, lounge, laundry



Self-Contained Flats

- Privacy
- More personal
- Staff on site
- Support in the community
- Don't usually have on site facilities



Shared Lives placements

- Home environment
- Support if you find it hard to live on your own
- Matched with carer
- Alternative to care home



Care Homes

- Accommodation and personal care
- For those who may not be able to live independently
- Trained staff

There are two main types of care homes - residential and nursing homes.

Residential care home

- Range in size.
- Support 24/7
- Staff help with all types of care
- Specialist residential care homes for complex needs



Nursing homes

- Range in size.
- Support 24/7 from qualified nurses
- Staff help with all types of care



When will things happen?

- Over the next 2 to 3 years or maybe longer



What will happen?

- Nothing if supported living is the best option for you
- No one will be made to move
- Your rights will be respected
- Maybe we will have fewer group homes
