Subject:	Removal of Buy with Confidence Scheme

1 Recommendations

- 1.1 It is recommended that members consider the proposal to cease the Buy with Confidence Scheme in order to achieve savings of £35k.

Reason for recommendation

- 1.2 The Public Protection Service delivers a diverse range of statutory regulatory functions under environmental health, trading standards and licensing legislation. The Buy with Confidence Scheme is a non-statutory scheme which provides trading standards approval to reputable local businesses.

2 Background

- 2.1 Cabinet in November 2014 approved the introduction of the Buy with Confidence Scheme (BWC) and provided funding.
- 2.2 Great effort has been made to get local businesses interested and on the Scheme. Whilst there has been some interest shown, only two local businesses are currently signed up to be members of the Scheme. In light of this the investment does not provide value for money.

3 Financial Implications

The saving proposal is 100% of the total budget dedicated to the area of service affected.
